

ICIC & ISAAR 2019 OVERVIEW

- The ICIC (International Interscience Conference on Infection and Chemotherapy) was founded by the Korean Society for Infectious Diseases (KSID) in 2013. It has been focusing on diverse topics on infectious diseases throughout the globe with regard to the epidemiology, diagnosis, treatment and prevention. Given the continuous emergence of infectious diseases in various parts of the world, effective international communication and collaboration is of critical importance.
- The ISAAR (International Symposium on Antimicrobial Agents and Resistance) has been organized by the Asia Pacific Foundation for Infectious Diseases (APFID) biennially since 1997. It is the Asia Pacific region's largest international symposium and has become the most representative international meeting on antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and development of novel antibiotics and vaccines.
- The KSID and APFID agreed to organize the joint meeting of the 4th ICIC and 12th ISAAR in 2019 since 2017 when they take place in Korea. Co-organized by 11 Korean academic societies/organizations, the ICIC & ISAAR have been growing as a global-scale meeting. They aim to contribute to the pivotal exchange of the state-of-the-art information and data on infectious diseases and antimicrobial resistance.
- The ICIC & ISAAR 2019 will provide a variety of programs with a strong emphasis on epidemiology, diagnosis and treatment of emerging infectious diseases. They also will cover various issues on AMR and the development of new antimicrobial agents and vaccines. Special lectures and presentations by world-leading scientists and physicians can foster global solutions to the problems of infectious diseases and AMR.

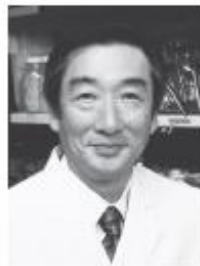

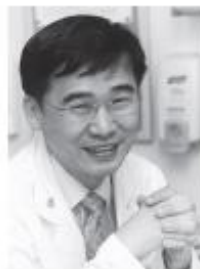
